

But what does the school board actually do?

In New Zealand, School Boards are responsible for the governance of the school and set together with the principal and teacher representatives the overall direction. The School Board works through the legislation and focuses on the strategic planning, and policy development of the school. This is important work as it allows the school to ensure it reflects the local voices of parents and the learning opportunities that drive its curriculum.

As you will be aware, we are a small rural school and therefore rely heavily on invested parents to support and drive the varied learning opportunities that exist for us in Lake Tekapo and surrounds. This cannot be taken for granted, with government and curriculum changes meaning support and understanding from the BOT is essential.

Being on the School Board is a tremendous opportunity to represent the community's voice, be part of decisions about the school's future, and work with others to create a positive learning environment for your children
